



GENERAL RULES:


- 1. You must be in K, 1st, or 2nd grade at the time you sign up for this project.

- 4. Be sure to check out the Indiana State Fair 4-H Rabbit Show. When you are a 3rd grader and a 4-H Rabbit member, you will be eligible to exhibit in the 4-H Rabbit classes at the State Fair.


OPTIONAL:

MINI PROJECTS INVOLVING POSTERS -





Rabbits are fast-moving, big-eared mammals. There are about 25 different species of rabbits. They live in a variety of environments, including deserts, swamps, marshes, forests, grasslands, and prairies. Rabbits are found on every continent except Antarctica.

Most rabbits live for about a year in the wild. They are hunted by dogs, foxes, raccoons, weasels, bobcats, lynxes, hawks, and eagles. They have a fast reproductive rate.

Anatomy: Rabbits range in size from 1 to 2 feet (30 to 60 cm) long. They have very big and powerful hind legs which they use for hopping and for digging burrows.

<u>Diet:</u> Rabbits are **herbivores** (plant-eaters). They eat grass, leaves, bark, and twigs.


<u>Classification:</u> Kingdom Animalia (animals), Phylum Chordata (having a notochord), Class Mammalia (mammals), order Lagomorpha (rabbits, hares, and pikas), Family Leporidae (rabbits and hares), many Genera.




