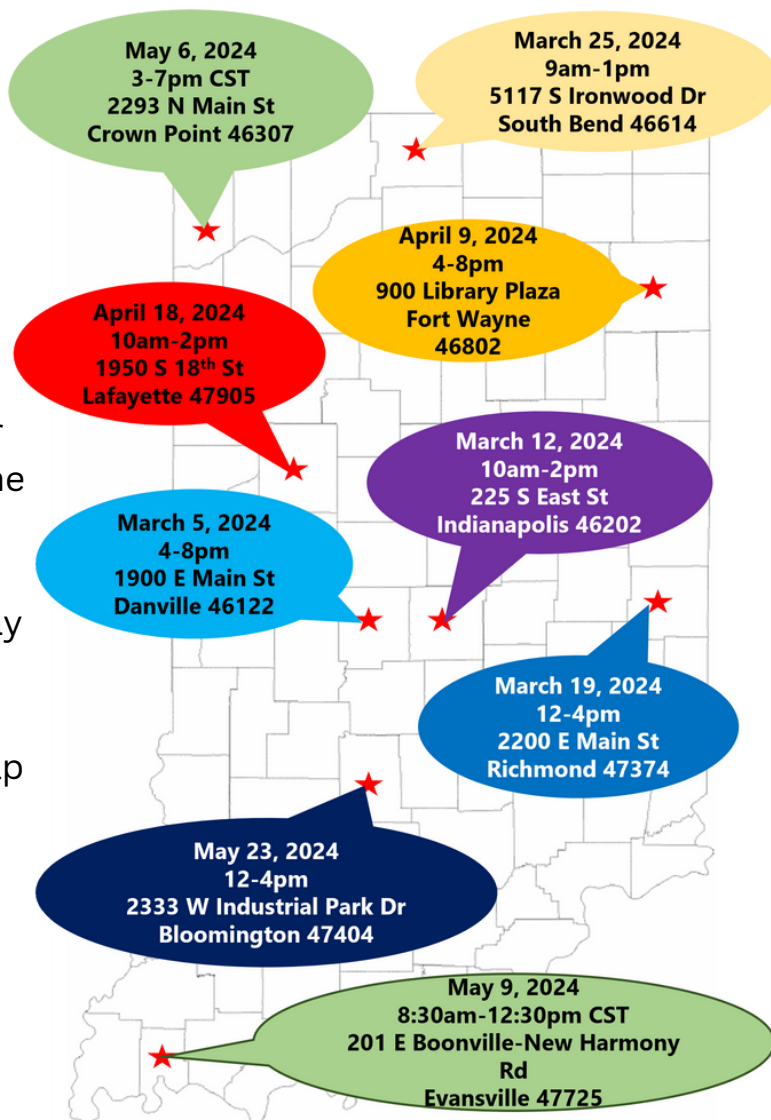
Also, USDA FNS will be at these events to help farmers sign-up for SNAP EBT. Market Managers are also welcome to attend.

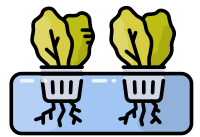




## Hydronic Lettuce Production Webinars
