- A. Official Scrapie identification tag, with US shield OR
- B. Official Scrapie tattoo **OR**
 - a. Must begin with the state postal code along with a unique individual animal ID number.
- C. Registration tattoo **OR**
 - a. Tattoo must be noted on the registration paper and accompany the animal.
- D. Registration microchip
 - a. Electronic implant must be noted on the registration paper and accompany the animal.
