Fair is right around the corner. Make sure you have completed your Fair Entry before coming to the fair. Please review the fair schedule thoroughly for livestock check in times and contact us with any questions.

### Pen Set Up, YQCA, Meat Pen Rabbit Tattooing on June 30th

Pen Set up & Exhibit Hall Clean Up will begin at 5:30 pm in the Sheep and Beef Barns.

YQCA will begin at 6:00 pm in the Community Building for those still needing the certification to show livestock at county and state fairs. Youth for Quality Care of Animals is a required training for all Indiana 4-H members who exhibit Dairy, Beef, Goat, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep and Swine. Registration is required online at vacaprogram.org. If you are not able to attend this program you can complete your certification online at yqcaprogram.org.

Meat Pen Rabbits are the only rabbits that need tattooed. The Rabbit Leaders will be set up to tattoo your rabbits in the back portion of the beef barn from 6-7:30 pm. A reminder you can tattoo 4 rabbits and bring the best 3 to the fair.

### **4-H Livestock Auction**

Due to continuing difficulty finding animal processor appointments the Jefferson County 4-H Fair Board will only be transporting Auction and Appraiser animals. If 4-H members have extra animals they will need to secure their own transportation and locker appointments.

### **Mandatory Livestock Auction Pic**tures begin at 6:00 am, Monday, July 11

All 4-H members selling in the livestock auction need to have their photo taken Monday morning. Please dress as you would for the show ring. Please report at the following times.



The Jefferson County 4-H Livestock auction continues to be an impressive community event benefiting both our members and the community. To continue this success we need to remember to show our appreciation to local businesses who support the auction. We can do this by attending Livestock Auction pictures. These photos are given to buyers to promote the livestock auction and thank them for their sponsorship. You can also make a point to personally thank your buyers with a handshake and maybe even a bottle of water. Writing Thank You letters is also strongly encouraged. Include what you learned this year raising your livestock, how you grew through your 4-H participation, and, if appropriate, how you plan to utilize the money you earned. Consider inviting them to participate in the auction ahead of time in person or through a written letter. Let local businesses know who you are, what you are raising and why you would appreciate their support.

\*This date does not apply to Single Vegetable, Garden Collection, Potato and Herb Exhibits, Food Baked, and Food Preserved.

**Single Vegetable, Garden Collection, and Potato and Herb Exhibits** will need to be dropped off at the Purdue Extension Jefferson County office by <u>Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup></u>.

Foods Baked and/or Preserved will need to be dropped off at the office by Tuesday, August 2nd at 4:00pm.

### **Animal Projects**

All animal projects headed to state fair that had their DNA collected at county tagging will need to enter their classes on the Indiana State Fair's Exhibitors Corner Website. Each animal department has their own deadlines and fees. Most of those deadlines do not close until a week before the respective show. However price increases as you get closer. If you are planning to show your animal at the state fair take advantage of early registration discounts by entering early. All exhibit hall projects, such as photography, are free and entered by the extension office after county fair judging.
