#### **News You Need to Know:**

#### **All 4-H Families-**

Enrollment dates for the 2023-2024 4-H Year!

Indiana 4-H program enrollments will open on October 1, 2023 and will end on May 15, 2024.

- You will use the <a href="https://in.4honline.com">https://in.4honline.com</a> website to re-enroll. **Please make sure you use Firefox, Google Chrome, or Safari when utilizing 4HOnline!**
- Current 4-H/Mini 4-H members must use the email and password that was used when you first created your family profile. If you do not know what email you used, call our office and we will be glad to assist you.
- 4-H members, regardless of age, must enroll as "Youth". This is true even for our older members who are, or may soon be, 18 years of age.

## Please do not create a new profile!

- **Do NOT create a new Family Profile!** Creating a new profile will result in slowing your enrollment process. We must delete the second profile you created and you will then have to re-enroll under your established profile.
- Do you need to add a family member to 4-HOnline? Be sure to add them to your current Family Profile. Do NOT create a new Family Profile!
  - ALL 4-H members and Mini 4-H members, and Adult Volunteers MUST reenroll each year!
  - You can also follow us on Facebook at Shelby County, In 4-H to keep up with the latest news.
  - **Poinsettia sales have begun!** Proceeds benefit all 4-H programs. Orders will be filled on a first come-first served basis and may be called in to our office. Plants come in red, white, pink, Shimmer Surprise and Ice Crystals and cost \$10

each. Plant pick up day is November 28th between 12 noon and 5 p.m. here at the extension office. See the order form on the back page.


