# **DESCRIPTION**

The intent of this project is to:

- Promote the 4-H Horse & Pony program through an educational poster.
- Involve and encourage younger 4-H'ers.
- Allow more 4-Hers to participate in equine education.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Participants must meet the requirements of the general 4-H Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Participants are not required to own, possess, or exhibit animals.
- 3. Participants should follow the standard 4-H poster guidelines, including: Poster size 22" x 28", display horizontally on foam backing and cover with protective clear plastic. Boards and sleeves are available at the Extension Office. Framed posters will not be accepted.
- 4. Posters should be informative, educational and fun.
- 5. Posters may include hand drawn pictures, photographs, cut-outs, charts, models, etc.
- 6. Completed posters shall be turned in at the Exhibit Hall on the second day of community judging.

### **EXHIBIT CLASS GUIDELINES:**

#### Beginner (grades 3-5 suggested)

Create an educational poster, notebook or display about any manual activity or on any equine related topic of choice that is age/grade appropriate.

Exhibit Topic Suggestions: parts of a horse, breeds of horses, different colors of horses, items used in proper grooming.

### Intermediate (grades 6-8 suggested)

Create an educational poster, notebook or display about any manual activity or on any equine related topic of choice that is age/grade appropriate.

Exhibit Topic Suggestions: tack information, gait of the horse, training information, hoof structure/foot care, horse safety.

# Advanced (grades 9-12 suggested)

Create an educational poster, notebook or display about any manual activity or on any equine related topic of choice that is age/grade appropriate.

Exhibit Topic Suggestions: anatomy, examples of unsoundness, horse digestive system, life cycles of internal parasites.
