- 4. Posters should be informative, educational and fun.
- 5. Posters may include hand drawn pictures, photographs, cut-outs, charts, models, etc.
- 6. Poster Divisions:

Beef Division-all ages Dairy Division-all ages Goat Division-all ages Sheep Division-all ages Swine Division-all ages

- 7. Completed posters shall be turned in at the Exhibit Hall on the second day of community judging.
- 8. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected from each division. Those posters will then be judged for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion.
