LET'S HAVE FUN AND BE CREATIVE WITH ARTS AND CRAFTS! IN THE MINI 4-H PROJECT, YOU MAY CHOOSE FROM A VARIETY OF CRAFTS AND USE YOUR IMAGINATION TO MAKE AS MANY DIFFERENT ARTICLES AS YOU WANT. IN MINI 4-H, YOU MAY ONLY EXHIBIT ONE CRAFT AT THE COUNTY FAIR.

HAVE YOU SEEN SOME CRAFT OBJECTS YOU WOULD LIKE TO HAVE? WELL, HERE'S YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE THEM.

REMEMBER THESE THINGS:

1. CHOOSE A CRAFT PROJECT YOU LIKE.
2. MAKE SURE YOU HAVE SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO MAKE YOUR CRAFT.
3. READ YOUR INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.
4. PURCHASE OR GATHER ALL MATERIALS YOU NEED FOR THE PROJECT BEFORE YOU BEGIN WORKING.
5. FIND A PLACE WHERE YOU CAN DO YOUR WORK.
6. ONCE YOU HAVE STARTED YOUR PROJECT, FINISH IT!
7. PUT YOUR CRAFT ITEM IN A PLACE WHERE IT CAN BE DISPLAYED.

1. YOU MUST BE BETWEEN KINDERGARTEN AND SECOND GRADE.
2. YOUR EXHIBIT WILL BE ONE SIMPLE ARTICLE YOU HAVE MADE.
3. YOU MUST EXHIBIT YOUR PROJECT AT THE WARRICK COUNTY 4-H FAIR, HELD AT THE WARRICK COUNTY 4-H CENTER IN BOONVILLE, IN.
4. YOUR ARTS AND CRAFTS PROJECT WILL BE DISPLAYED IN A SPECIAL MINI 4-H SECTION AT THE 4-H FAIR.
5. THERE WILL BE SUGGESTIONS FROM A JUDGE ON YOUR PROJECT. YOU WILL RECEIVE A MINI 4-H RIBBON FOR EXHIBITING AT THE COUNTY FAIR.
6. YOU MUST EXHIBIT A DIFFERENT ARTS & CRAFTS PROJECT EACH YEAR.
