LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

<u>Private Pesticide Applicators</u>: Pass the CORE exam; complete the Application for Private Applicator Permit; mail application and payment to the Office of the Indiana State Chemist.

<u>Private Manure Applicators</u>: Pass the Category 14 exam; complete the Application for Private Applicator Permit; mail application and payment to the Office of the Indiana State Chemist.


<u>Commercial Applicators</u>: Pass the CORE exam; Pass the Category Exam(s); complete the Application for Indiana Pesticide Credentials; mail application and payment to the Office of the Indiana State Chemist.

EXAMS

- 1. Attending a training is not required, but is helpful for some. Training is available at Purdue University (see attached brochure) or regionally (see attached flyer).
- 2. Training manuals are available online or ordered through the Purdue Extension Washington County office. Most manuals are \$40 + shipping. If attending a training, confirm if manuals are a part of the training fees.

- 3. Exams are administered at testing centers. Ivy Tech in Sellersburg and Columbus are the closest testing centers for Washington County. To schedule a test:
 - a. Visit http://indiana.metrosignup.com to create an account.
 - b. Return to the site above and log-in with the created credentials to select a testing center and a date(s)/time(s) for the exam(s). The exam fee is approx. \$55.
- 4. Once exam(s) are passed, complete the required application and send with payment to the Office of the Indiana State Chemist (see attached applications).

REMINDERS:

- GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO ID'S ARE REQUIRED AT TESTING CENTERS.
- TAKE A CALCULATOR TO THE TESTING CENTER, CELL PHONES CANNOT BE USED AS CALCULATORS.
- AN EXAM MAY NOT BE ATTEMPTED MORE THÂN 3 TIMES IN A 12 MONTH PERIOD.

Core/Category Pre-Certification Training

- Training prepares for certification exams, and is NOT approved for CCHs (continuing certification hours).

A Certification Exam WILL NOT be given at training sessions.

- \$103/person for each session.
- Advanced registration required.
- Registration includes the corresponding training manual.
- Training manual shipped in advance to the address listed on registration. Clients are encouraged to study the training manual before attending training session.
- Cancellation required 5 days in advance of session to receive a refund.
- A cancellation fee will be charged.
- NO refund given for training manual.
- Training session will be cancelled if miniumum registration is not met.
- Certification Exams only available from Metro Institute, over 20 statewide locations.
