Deadline Reminder

Projects/Livestock that are not entered in 4-H Online by May 15th will not be eligible to be exhibited/shown. Discretion may be used for unique circumstances.

May 15th is the final day that 4-H members can make changes to their project enrollment. Make sure you have selected only the projects you intend to show at the county/state fair within 4-H Online.

All applicable livestock species* need to be correctly identified (with the proper forms of ID) in the 4-H Online system by May 15th. A copy of appropriate registrations papers, DNA hair samples, and any County Born & Raised Beef papers need to be turned into the Extension Office by May 15th as well.

*Beef, Dairy, Goat, Horse, Rabbit, Sheep, Swine Poultry information will be entered at a later time in FairEntry.
