  - -Chalk


Use your imagination; there are many things you can draw!

-Crayons


What you will do:


- 1. On a flat surface, arrange your objects for rubbing

- Glue or paint if necessary


# What you will do:

# Finishing your exhibit

Now that you have completed your craft project it is time to prepare it for the fair!

If you did your art or craft project on a sheet of paper or poster board, you will want to display it on a poster. Your poster should be 14x22 and should be displayed horizontally. Other crafts can be exhibited however is best. An open shoe box or display board are good options. Please make sure there are no loose pieces that may fall off.

Fill out a exhibit tag and attach it the bottom right hand corner of your project, cover your poster board with clear plastic and your project is ready for the fair!
