Food/Health Tid-Bit

Did you know February is heart month? Heart disease is the number one cause of death among men and women across the nation. Each year, approximately 610,000 Americans die from heart disease, accounting for nearly 1 out of every 4 deaths. Heart disease is also

the number one cause of death for men and women in Indiana. Ways to love your heart:

- Healthy diet
- Maintain weight
- Get Active
- Reduce Stress
- Manage/control lab values (cholesterol, blood sugar, blood pressure)
- Quit smoking

Heart Healthy Recipe

Slow Cooker Vegetable Turkey Soup

Servings 6 Serving Size 2 cups

- 1 pound ground skinless turkey breast
- 3 large carrots, sliced crosswise into rounds
- 2 medium zucchini, halved lengthwise and sliced
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 128-ounce can no-salt-added tomato sauce
- 115.5-ounce can no-salt-added cannellini beans, rinsed and drained
- 2 medium garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tablespoon dried Italian seasoning, crumbled
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 4 cups fat-free, low-sodium chicken broth

Directions

- Put all the ingredients in a slow cooker, stirring to combine and breaking up the turkey.
- Cook, covered, on low for 8 hours, or until the turkey is no longer pink.

INDIANA 4-H LIVESTOCK QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM

Livestock members are required to participate in a livestock quality assurance program. Two options (found below) are available to our members for completion of the requirement.



Beef/Dairy Steer, Dairy, Sheep, Goat, Swine, Rabbit, & Poultry members are REQUIRED to complete ONE of the options listed below to be eligible for show at the 2024 Hendricks County Fair!

OPTION 1: In-Person Training

In-person training for the NEW Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program is scheduled to take place at the Hendricks County Fairgrounds. Dates are listed below. ***Only need to attend ONE training time.** Cost is \$3.

OPTION 2: Online Training

Online training through Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is available at www.yqcaprogram.org. Cost is \$12. Test-out option is available for an additional fee.

ONLY ONE OPTION IS REQUIRED. Please pick the best option for you. You do not have to complete both in-person and online training. You MUST be able to prove you took one of the two trainings!
