Registration deadline is April $19^{\text {th }}$ the registration will shut off at 5:00 pm EST. Pre-registration is required. Any registered contestant who is a no-show must still pay the registration fee no refunds will be given. Registration fees may be sent to the State 4-H Office, 615 Mitch Daniels Blvd., West Lafayette, IN 47907 or paid the day of the event. Please refer to Ag Judging late payment policy.
