The Indiana State Poultry Association is providing an opportunity for a free flock evaluation. The voluntary testing program, referred to as Indiana's Test Twelve (12) program monitors Avian Influenza and other common avian diseases through a simple antibody test from your hens eggs.

To participate, contact the ISPA for an egg mailing kit. Upon receiving the kit, collect 12 eggs and return them to the ISPA in a postage paid package. The results of the test will be mailed to you, along with a free gift for participating!

NOTE: As this is a monitoring test only, the results are for the poultry owners benefit and cannot be used to certify egg quality or as a replacement to poultry health papers
