- Opportunity for self-determination

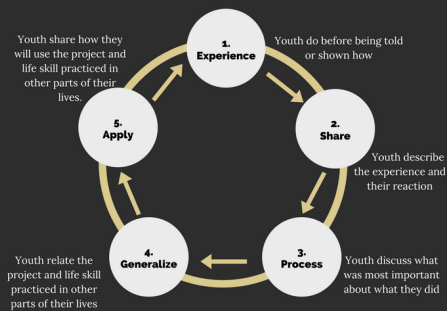


GENEROSITY
