TIPS AND GUIDELINES

PLANNING THE REQUEST:

- FOCUS THE REQUEST ON THE NEEDS AND INTERESTS OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY
- SHOW THE GROUP HAS A WELL-DEVELOPED FINANCIAL PLAN, A REPUTATION FOR BEING FAIR, IS COMMUNITY-MINDED, AND IS WELL-ORGANIZED
- DEMONSTRATE THAT MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL HAVE GIVEN A PERSONAL GIFT TO THE PROGRAM BEFORE ASKING OTHERS TO CONTRIBUTE

THE REQUEST SHOULD BE GIVEN BY SOMEONE WHO:

- LIVES, WORKS, AND VOLUNTEERS IN THEIR COMMUNITY
- IS EXCITED, KNOWLEDGEABLE, INVOLVED, AND GIVES OF THEMSELVES

FUNDRAISING

ALL FUNDRAISING MUST BE CONDUCTED IN COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL USDA GUIDELINES

USE OF THE 4-H NAME OR EMBLEM IS FORBIDDEN IF IT EXPLOITS:

- 4-H AS A PROGRAM
- 4-H VOLUNTEERS
- 4-H PARTICIPANTS
- THE USDA
- PURDUE EXTENSION
- THE LAND GRANT INSTITUTION OR ITS EMPLOYEES

FUNDRAISING MAY BE CARRIED OUT FOR SPECIFIC EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES

EACH ORGANIZATION MUST BE ABLE TO SHOW PROOF OF AUTHORIZATION TO USE THE 4-H NAME/EMBLEM

THE 4-H NAME/EMBLEM MAY NEVER BE USED FOR ANY FUNDRAISING INVOLVING GAMES OF CHANCE SUCH AS RAFFLES, BINGO, ETC.
