## Indiana 4-H Civic Engagement Activity

### Finance Jeopardy

**Audience:** Volunteers **Duration:** 45 minutes (when using all slides)

**Overview:** Use this fun, engaging method to review the do's and don'ts of 4-H Club finances.

**Objectives:** Participants in this session will:

- Understand and follow expectations related to 4-H finances.
- Help train youth treasurers to follow proper protocol

#### Materials

- Computer, Projector, and Projector Screen
- "Finance Jeopardy" PowerPoint and "Finance Jeopardy – Questions & Answers" Word file
- Sound maker for each team
- Dry erase marker and board or flip chart paper and maker (for tallying scores)

#### Instructions

- Divide your audience into two or more teams, and give them each a sound maker to use as a "buzzer."
- Explain that after a clue is read, the first team to "buzz" in will have the opportunity to provide the question (Jeopardy style).
  - If they answer correctly, they will be awarded the points and they will select the next clue
  - If they answer incorrectly, the next team to buzz in can attempt to answer. If they get it correct, they get the points and select the next clue.
- Once everyone understands the rules, proceed through the slides as if you are the game show host.
  - Start by introducing the categories, then randomly select a team to select the first category.
  - Click the \$ amount hyperlink to proceed to the appropriate slide. Read the clue and select the team that "buzzes" in first.
  - Award points as needed.
- For the Daily Double: proceed as usual, but the team with the correct answer will get twice the points.
- For Final Jeopardy:
  - Each team "wagers" any amount up to the total points they have.
  - Then the clue is read and each team writes down an answer.
  - Once all teams have written an answer, they each share their response.
    - The correct responses are awarded the number of points they wagered.
    - For incorrect responses, the team loses the number of points they wagered.

**Facilitator note:** You can distribute the "Finance Jeopardy Questions & Answers" Document for participants to take with them for later review.

#### Discussion Questions

- What did you find the most interesting/surprising?
- What is one change you want to help your club make with their finances?
