The Caught Red-Handed is a security system for your laptop/desktop that protects your information. It uses a motion trigger to trigger a light and camera that takes a picture of the intruder.

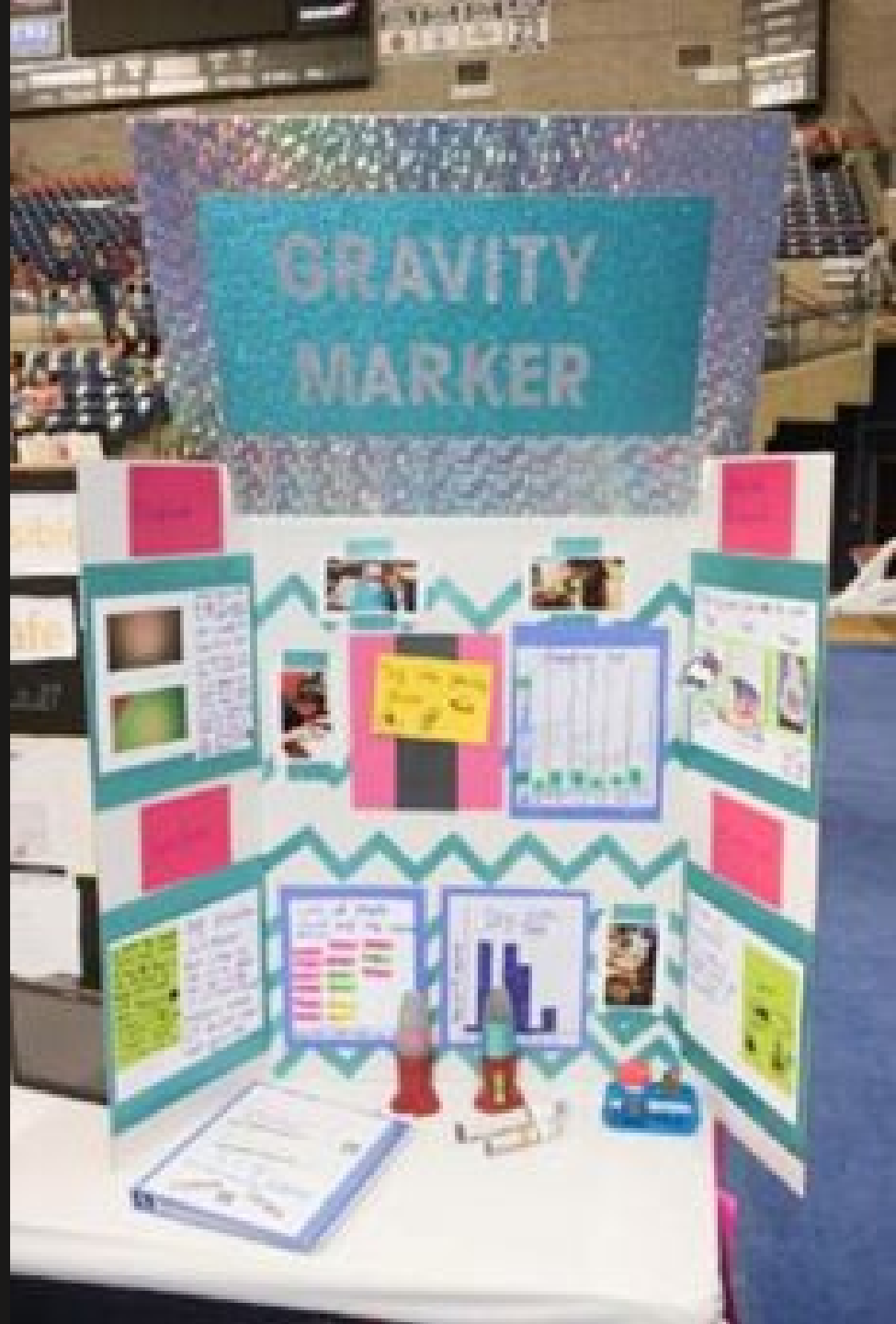


littleBits

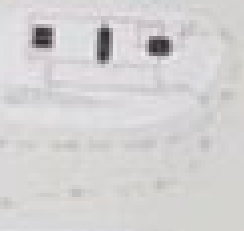

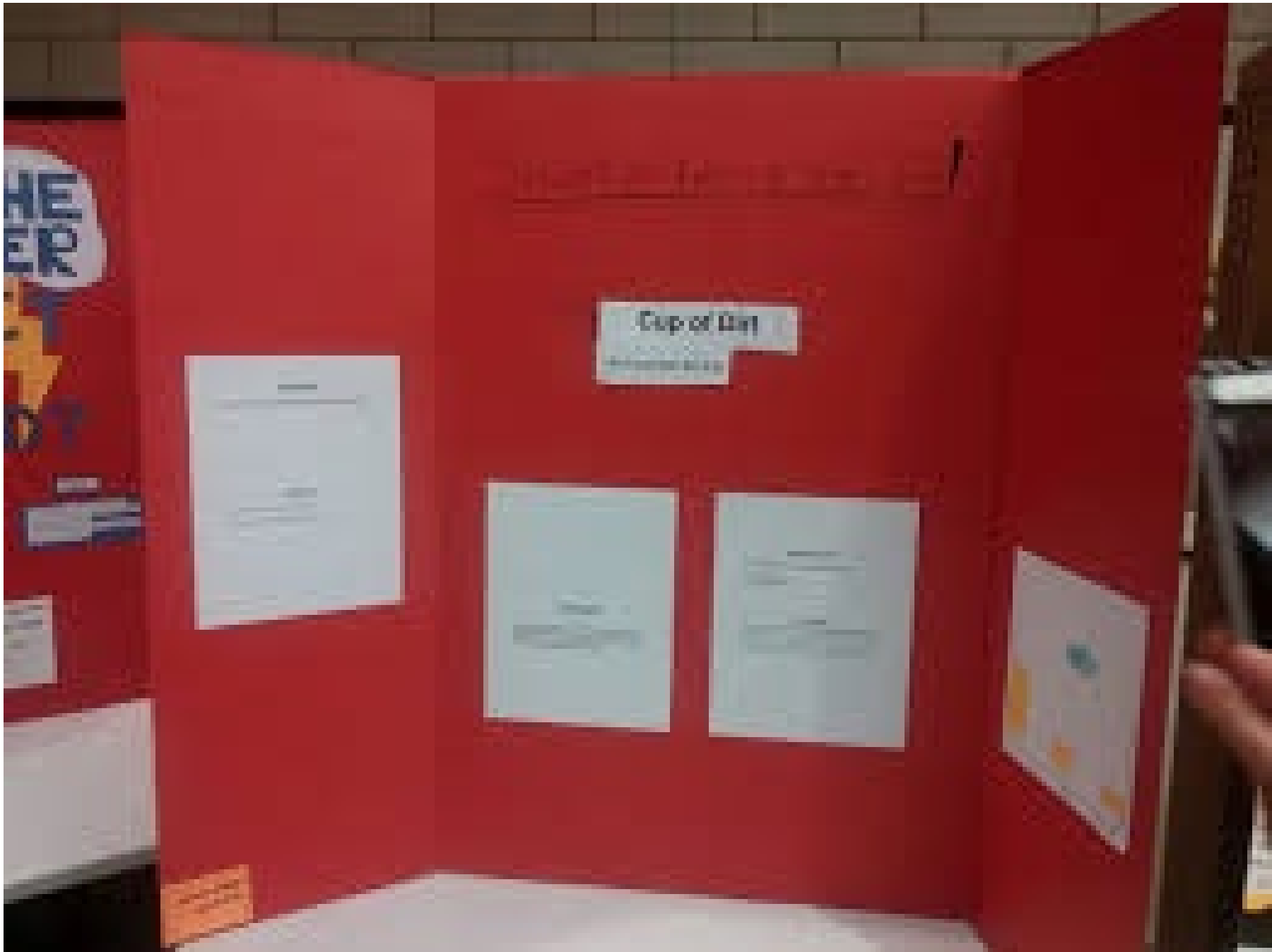

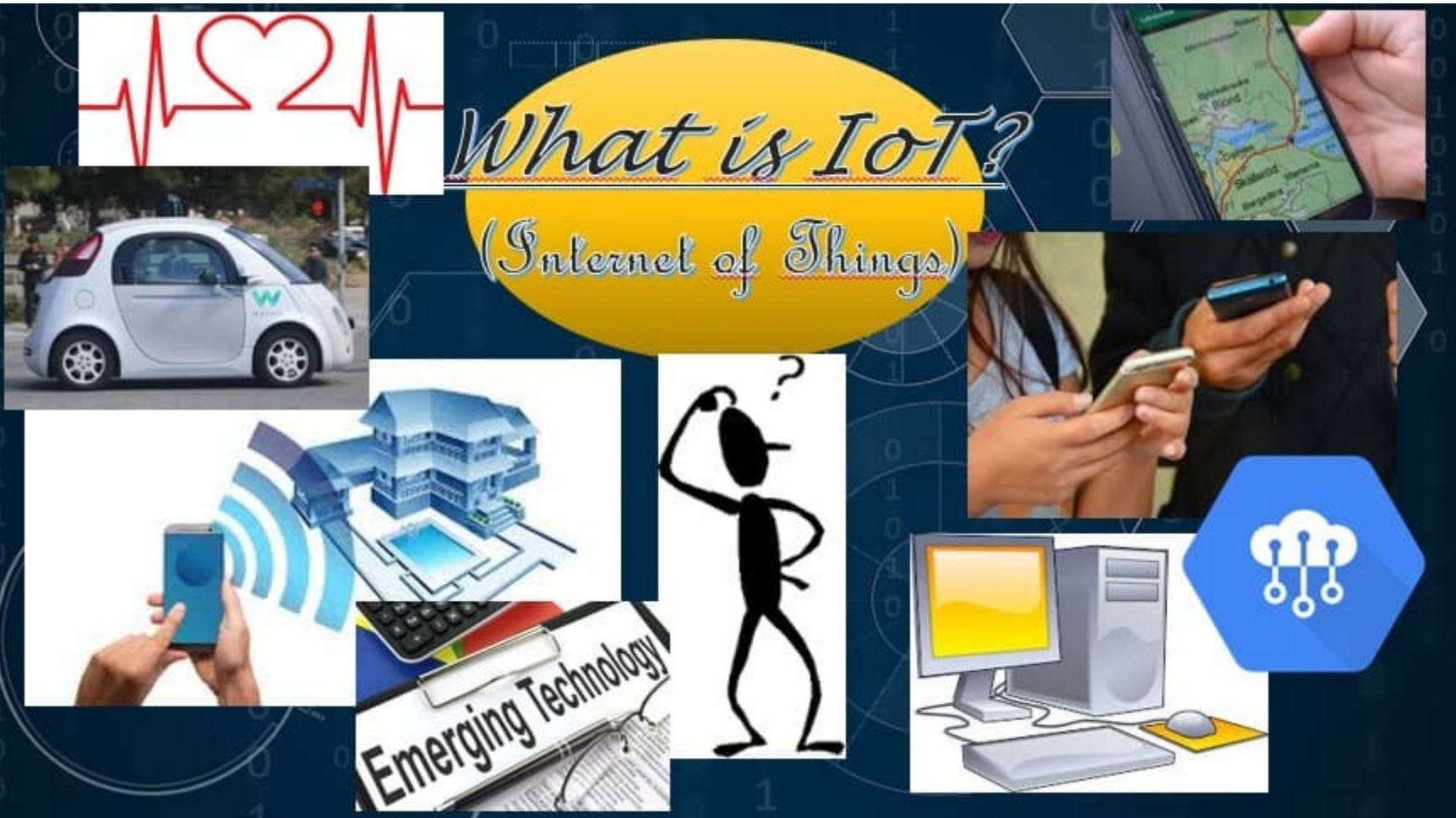
How to make a Good First Impression

INTRODUCTION

Motor Car, any self-propelled vehicle with more than two wheels and a passenger compartment, capable of being steered by the operator for use on roads. The term is used more specifically to denote any such vehicle designed to carry a maximum of seven people.

The primary components of a car are the power plant, the power transmission, the running gear, and the control system. These constitute the chassis, on which the body is mounted.
