Club Report/Activity – No Bull Challenge: Bullying

Audience: Grades 3-12

Duration: Approximately 20 minutes

Overview

4-H is a partner/sponsor in the “Great American No Bull Challenge.” Use the presentation videos and corresponding Power Points to start discussion at a club meeting around the topic of Bullying and considering developing your own Public Service Announcement.

Objectives

NO BULL motivates and inspires youth to speak up, affect change at the youth level and demonstrate leadership skills through the creation of short film and public service announcements. Those watching and participating in discussion will:

- Explore the impact of bullying
- Consider how they can make a difference
