What to Do	What to Say
<b>Chart #1</b>	Review main elements of a good demonstration from Y744 Let's Demonstrate.
<b>Demonstration cards</b>	Project leaders may want to add cards specific to a project area.
<b>Demonstration bag and props</b>	Have a volunteer or assigned 4-H member draw the card from the grab bag. The person will then demonstrate what is on the card (reference the poster to check for good format).

<p><b>Wash your face</b></p> <p>Prop: soap, water, wash cloth, and towel</p>	<p><b>Repot a plant</b></p> <p>Prop: plant, new pot, potting soil, and water</p>	<p><b>Make a glass of Chocolate Milk</b></p> <p>Prop: milk, cup, spoon, chocolate</p>
<p><b>Draw a square</b></p> <p>Prop: marker and paper</p>	<p><b>Do a push up</b></p>	<p><b>Put on a jacket or coat</b></p> <p>Prop: jacket or coat</p>

<p><b>Blow bubbles</b></p> <p>Prop: bubble soap and wand</p>	<p><b>Tie a shoe</b></p> <p>Prop: tie shoe or cardboard replica</p>	<p><b>Set a table</b></p> <p>Prop: plate, fork, knife, spoon, napkin, glass</p>
<p><b>Make a paper airplane</b></p> <p>Prop: sheet of paper</p>	<p><b>Brush your teeth</b></p> <p>Prop: toothbrush and toothpaste</p>	<p><b>Place photo in frame</b></p> <p>Prop: photo and frame</p>
<p><b>Measure a cup of water</b></p> <p>Prop: liquid measuring cup and water</p>	<p><b>Braid hair or rope</b></p> <p>Prop: volunteer with long hair or 3 pieces of rope</p>	<p><b>Unwrap gum</b></p> <p>Prop: gum (dispose of wrapper properly)</p>

<p><b>Shuffle a deck of cards</b></p> <p>Prop: deck of cards</p>	<p><b>Wrap a gift</b></p> <p>Prop: box, wrapping paper, tape, scissors</p>	<p><b>Make a paper fan</b></p> <p>Prop: paper</p>
<p><b>Make a Kleenex carnation</b></p> <p>Prop: Kleenex and pipe cleaner</p>	<p><b>Peel an Orange</b></p> <p>Prop: orange and a peeler or a spoon</p>	<p><b>Wipe a table</b></p> <p>Prop: table and cloth</p>
<p><b>Sharpen a pencil</b></p> <p>Prop: Pencil and sharpener</p>	<p><b>Tie a neck tie</b></p> <p>Prop: Neck tie and volunteer</p>	<p><b>Shine your shoes</b></p> <p>Prop: shoe and shine materials</p>
<p><b>Crack an egg for cooking</b></p> <p>Prop: egg, bowl, knife, towels</p>	<p><b>Separate the yolk from the white of an egg</b></p> <p>Prop: egg, bowl, towels</p>	<p><b>Measure 2/3 cup of flour</b></p> <p>Prop: measuring cups, flour, bowl</p>
<p><b>Cut a 4 ½" board</b></p> <p>Prop: board, hand saw, measuring tape, pencil</p>	<p><b>Make a peanut butter and jelly sandwich</b></p> <p>Prop: peanut butter, jelly, bread, knife, plate</p>	<p><b>Curl ribbon for a gift</b></p> <p>Prop: different ribbons and scissors</p>
<p><b>Tie a square knot</b></p> <p>Prop: rope and directions</p>	<p><b>Paint your fingernails</b></p> <p>Prop: nail polish, remover, volunteer</p>	<p><b>Peel a banana</b></p> <p>Prop: banana</p>

# Elements of a Good Demonstration

- Introduction
  - Topic suitable to your age and experience
- Body
  - Plan the demonstration
  - Collect materials needed
  - Develop an outline
- Summary
  - Main points to remember
  - Display finished product
  - Clean up
- Questions
  - Ask for questions
  - Repeat question prior to answering.
  - Add a courteous ending
