#### Site Scoring System Summary

Scoring system awards points for odor abatement practices, buffers above the minimum standard, density of surrounding area, homestead on property among other things. Points can be deducted for an IDEM/EPA violation. To receive permit without a special exception applicant must score 220 point out of possible 415.
