Manual Availability

If you feel that you would benefit from a project manual, please do not hesitate to reach out to the Extension Office and we would be glad to provide whatever resource we have.

Universal Record Sheet

All Adams County 4-H members who plan to exhibit at the Adams County 4-H Fair must submit a <u>Universal 4-H</u>
<u>Record Sheet</u> to the Extension Office by 4:00PM on July 1st.

Additionally, those youth **exhibiting livestock** need to attend a workshop **OR** complete the Livestock Record Sheet and submit it to the Extension Office by 4:00PM on July 1st.

Skills Cards, Recipe Cards, Vaccination Sheets, etc.

Some projects require additional cards and forms which will be indicated in the project guidelines. These can be found online on the Indiana 4-H webpage under each project https://extension.purdue.edu/4-H/projects, your 4-H leaders or we have copies of these available in our office to hand out, email or even mail to you, please reach out to us and we can get you taken care of.





Livestock Identification Dates

All identification dates happen at the Adams County 4-H Fairgrounds, specific details sent to those enrolled in each species.

Premise ID

Premise ID is issued by the Indiana Board of Animal Health (BOAH) and serves much like a social security number for your farm. BOAH uses the Premise ID to assist with tracking of animals, especially in the event that an animal health issue arises they are able to help track those animals.

Premise IDs are a seven digit alpha-numeric ID, usually starting with 00.

If you house animals at another location, check with the property owner for the Premise ID number.



Animal ID Deadline - May 15

Some livestock have earlier ID days, however those ID days are simply to get animals tagged and weighed. Information is gathered and provided for the family at those ID days but it is your responsibility then to go into the 4HOnline system to officially enter those livestock.

All animals must be identified and entered into 4HOnline (v2.4honline.com);

which is the same place where 4-H'ers enroll themselves in the 4-H program and sign-up for events **by May 15th.**

This does not include:

Cats, Dogs and Small Animals
Poultry is NOT entered online*
*Poultry has paper enrollment due May 15.

Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program

Those youth exhibiting cattle, goats, poultry, rabbits, sheep and swine must complete an annual animal care certification.
