These trainings will be available in 4-H Online beginning October 1st after you have submitted your re-enrollment. We are asking that everyone who wishes to be a 4-H Volunteer complete this training by January 1, 2026. We be offering an in-person training on October 7, at the Extension office starting at 6pm. The training will take approximately 1 hour to complete.

We understand that everyone's time is valuable, but our main goal is keeping our 4-H Youth safe.

Along with your training, you must sign a Role Description Agreement. Please make sure you are selecting the correct role! You can have more than one role.
