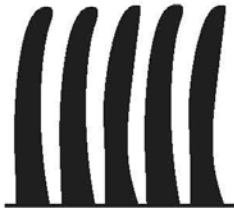

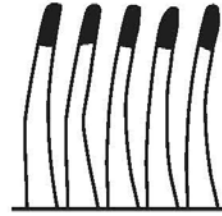

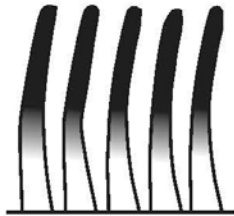
HAIR COLORING



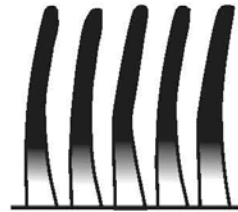
The hair is totally one color.



Only the tip is colored. The base is white.



Half the hair is colored, blending to a white base.

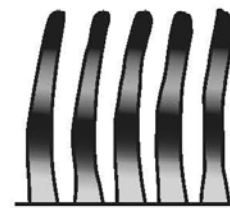


Most of the hair is colored with a white base.

TABBY, TICKED, OR AGOUTI



The color is broken into bands, the outer tips usually being the darkest and the base the lightest.



A short hair can have as few as 3 bands of color. A long hair can have 5 to 8 bands of color.
