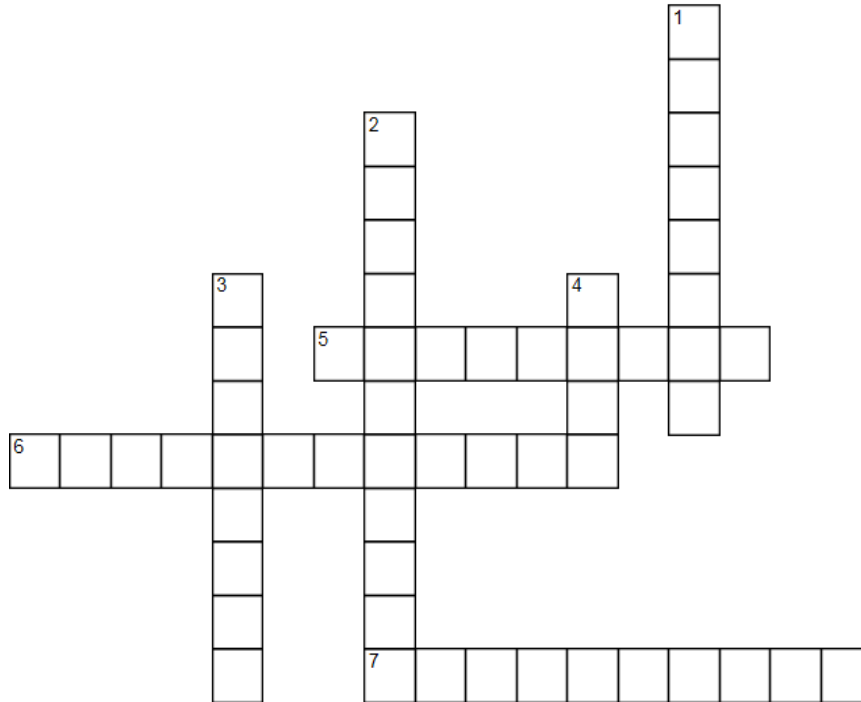

ACROSS

- 5 If the horse has several of these parasites in its cecum the horse may show develop colic, ulcers and diarrhea.
- 6 These parasites have an internal and an external cycle on the horse.
- 7 This is the most harmful of all internal parasites

DOWN

- 1 These insects are more irritating than harmful to a horse.
- 2 Also called Strongyloides Westeri
- 3 This parasite matures in the small intestines and lays eggs there.
- 4 These adult flies lay eggs on the hair of the horse and the egg hatches when the horse licks its hair and digests the larvae.
