





Boone County 4-H members who are showing livestock that are being housed at another location other than your home MUST fill the following form out by <u>May 15th, 2024</u>.








Boone County Indiana 4-H Livestock Care Training



4-H members who are planning to exhibit cattle, sheep, goats, swine, rabbits and/or poultry this year at the county and/or state fair are REQUIRED complete the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Training. This training takes place in person and the cost is \$3 per 4-H member.

Dates offered (you only need to attend 1 training session): -May 13th @ 7pm -May 28th @ 7pm All trainings will take place at the Boone County 4-H Fairgrounds.

Who Can Enter: This contest is open to 3rd - 12th grade students living in Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Marion, Morgan, and Shelby counties. Young people do not need to be registered in 4-H to participate in the Central Indiana contest, but must pay a \$15 4-H registration fee to advance to the state contest.

Entry Guidelines:

Individual or Small Group - Musical:

- Number of performers: 1-4 performers
- Performance time limit: 3-5 minutes
- Types of acts: instrumental, vocal, band performances, etc.

Individual or Small Group - Non-Musical:

- Number of performers: 1-4 performers
- Performance time limit: 3-5 minutes
- Types of acts: skits or sketches, magic, clowning, rhythmic gymnastics, reading,
- cheerleading routines, dance, lip sync, juggling, puppetry, etc.

Large group:

- -Number of performers: five (5) or more performers
- Performance time limit: 5-8 minutes
- Types of acts: skits or sketches, choral number, dance routines, lip sync, etc.

All entries will be judged by a panel in May, and results shared in June. Winning acts may advance to perform at 4-H Round-Up!
