

- 9. A written record of a rabbit's ancestors, going back at least three generations on both the dam's and the sire's sides.
- 10. A mottling of eye color.
- 11. Ear canker, slobbers, potbelly, vent disease or abscesses.
- 12. Buck or wolf teeth.
- 13. Disqualify when noted in the breed standard.

- 1. Any dying, plucking, trimming or clipping so as to alter appearance.
- 2. The body structure and weight conforming to the standard type of the breed represented.
