A	When viewing the hind legs from the rear, the hocks are turned inward or are placed close together, causing the toes to turn outward.		
В	When viewing the rear legs from the side, the hock has too much angle or set, causing the animal to stand far underneath itself. Often these animals will droop excessively from hooks to pins.		
C	The hock has too little angle or set. The animal is too straight through the joint, resulting in stiff, restricted movement because of lack of flexibility.
