Guidelines and Requirements

- I. Eligibility
 - a. High School Senior
 - b. Must have completed three (3) years in Junior Leadership and five (5) years in 4-H Club work. (This includes the year in which you apply for the scholarship.)
 - c. Must be enrolled in an institute of higher learning (does not include correspondence schools) for the Fall term.
- II. Selection
 - a. Active 4-H Junior Leader work
 - b. Outstanding 4-H Club work
 - c. Grades
- III. Amount
 - a. The number and amount of scholarships will be determined by the number of applications and by the funds raised through the 4-H Ambassador Contest.
