Welcome to "MINI 4-H". If you're reading this, you've probably signed up for the Livestock project. We're glad to have you. Mini 4-H Livestock is for small farmers like yourself who are just starting out and want to learn more about caring for their livestock.

What we hope you will learn while taking Livestock is outlined below. They are called "Project Objectives".

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- 1. I will learn how to identify different parts of my animal.
- 2. I will learn how to keep accurate records on my animal.
- 3. I will have the responsibility of caring for my animal.

START

- a. Choose one (1) of your favorite animals to work with (Beef, goat, dairy, horse & pony, poultry, rabbit, sheep or swine). Complete your specific animal's diagram by labeling the parts correctly. (Try labeling some of the other animal diagrams to learn about other animals also.) If you need help identifying the parts, ask your parents, 4-H Leader or a Junior Leader.
- b. Take a look at your daily check sheet. Keep this handy so you can mark it every day. A place in your barn would be good.



FOOD

Animals are like you. They like good clean food and they like to be fed on time. Give your animal a balanced diet. Make sure it provides adequate nourishment for a healthy animal.

Keep fresh water available at all times. Do not use the same pan for water that you use for food.



- 1. Do you always remember to feed your animal?
- 2. Do you feed your animal at the same time each day?
- 3. Does your animal always have a clean food pan?
- 4. Do you always have clean, fresh water for your animal?

EXERCISE

Animals like to run and play. They also need exercise. Spend some time with your animal each day. Help it grow strong and healthy.

- 1. Do you take time to work with your animal each day?
- 2. Do you enjoy working with your animal?

CARE

Animals are like you, they need proper care too. They like to be kept clean and healthy. They enjoy nice, clean, dry beds to sleep in too.

- 1. Do you brush or groom your animal at least once a week?
- 2. Have you washed your animal on a warm sunny day?
- 3. Do you make sure your animal has a nice, clean, dry bed?
- 4. Do you care for your animal when it is sick?
