

#### **Farm Scene**

### **Description:**

Allows youth to learn life skills and grow in project knowledge while expressing creativity when designing replicas.

### **State Fair Entries:**

1 entry per county as determined by the county 4-H educator and fair officials.

#### **Exhibit Guidelines:**

The purpose of this project is to motivate and interest young people in designing a scaled model of a farm scene. Members can create a realistic setting around manufactured or custom-built farm toys. There are many different artistic abilities one can use in building a farm or agricultural related display. Members will use these skills to create a Farm Scene exhibit and display their work at the Clay County Fair.

- 1. Complete the **Farm Scene Record Sheet** and include with your exhibit.
- 2. Exhibit displays must be built on rigid material that will not bend.
- 3. Members are encouraged to use their imagination and creativity in designing his/her Farm Scene exhibit. Judging is based on creativity not on the amount of money spent for materials.
- 4. No water or live exhibit.

All arts and craft exhibits must include **a 4-H Craft Information Card**, **4-H 618A**. This information card is to describe work completed so the judge can more accurately evaluate the exhibit. Craft information cards are for judging purposes only and will not be returned to the exhibitor.

If an exhibitor is concerned about their creation being damaged while on display, they should consider constructing a clear plastic cover to encase the exhibit.

Judges evaluating exhibits should recognize individual differences and creativity, therefore using information in this document as a guide rather than a requirement.

## **Exhibit Class Guidelines:**

• Beginner (grades 3-5)

Exhibit a Farm Scene display. Exhibit shall be 24" x 36". Exhibit must involve fieldwork tilling (i.e., toy plows, tractors, disc, or planting). Roads, lanes, trees, fence rows, and back drops may be used to set off field (s). **Animals and buildings are allowed**.



### • Intermediate (grades 6-8)

Exhibit a Farm Scene display. Exhibit shall be 24" x 48". Exhibit shall involve any type of fieldwork (i.e., tilling, tractors or crop harvesting). Roads, lanes, trees, fence rows, and back drops may be used to set off field. Animals and buildings are encouraged. At least 1 structure is required.

# • Advanced (grades 9-12)

Exhibit one (1) of the following:

- 1. Farm Scene display. Exhibit shall not exceed 48" x 48". Exhibit is open to any type of farm (i.e., farmstead buildings, grain handling equipment, fieldwork or harvesting). Purchased buildings and prefabricated landscape are not permitted.
- 2. Agricultural Scene display. Exhibit shall not exceed 48" x 48". Exhibit shall be an agricultural setting of places, businesses, events, etc., except for farmsteads or farm tillage (i.e., livestock auctions, farm equipment dealership, agricultural educational events, field days, etc.).

#### Clay County Requirement:

You will need to have a filled-out project record sheet to turn in with your project at judging.
