Amateur Open Class

1. The amateur class is open to all Clay County residents.
2. Entries will be received in the north entrance of the Schopmeyer Ag building between 10am and 12:30pm on Tuesday July 21, 2026. Judging will take place at 1pm. Late entries will be exhibited but will not be judged.
3. Flower exhibits will be released Friday July 24, 2026 from 7-9pm and Saturday July 25 from 8am-10am. Please pick up your exhibit at this time.
4. First, second, and third place in each class and a champion and reserve champion ribbon in each division. Overall division winner will receive a trophy.
5. One entry per class per exhibitor.
6. Exhibitor must have grown all entries.
7. Arrangements must be the work of the exhibitor.
8. Planted flowers and foliage should be in containers no larger than 15" X 15". Anything larger will not be judged.
9. Containers and accessories are entered at owner's risk.
10. Artificial flowers and foliage will not be permitted except in a silk flower arrangement.
11. "Fresh cut plant material" includes flowers, branches, foliage, and any foliage and fruit on a living stem.
12. All cut flowers must be exhibited in any size beverage bottle. When possible, cut flowers need foliage on stem.

Arrangements Classes

- A. Holiday- A creation of silk, fresh or dried materials (accessories may be used)
- B. Midnight Madness- All shades of purple, lavender and/or blue fresh cut flowers
- C. Mixed Bouquet- Fresh cut flowers in a container
- D. Arrangement in a Unique Container- Fresh cut flowers in a unique container
- E. Tea Cup- Fresh cut flowers in a tea cup
- F. Sunshine Delight- All shades or yellow and orange fresh cut flowers
- G. Tom Thumb- Fresh cut flowers, not over 4" including container
- H. Three of a Kind- Blossoms of one flower variety in a container
- I. Silk & Dried- Silk and/or dried materials in an arrangement

- B. Flowering
- C. Herb House Plant

Cut Flower Classes- Single bloom of one specimen exhibited in a beverage bottle

- A. Gladiolas
- B. Marigold
- C. Rose
- D. Zinnia

- I. Any other flower

Youth Division- Preschool to 6th grade

- A. Any cut flower in a beverage bottle
- B. Any cut flower(s) in a favorite toy (no larger than 8" X 8")

Youth Division- 7th grade to 12th grade

- A. Any cut flower in a beverage bottle
- B. Any cut flower(s) in a unique container (no larger than 8" X 8")
