Eligibility:

- Must have a high school grade point average of at least 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Each applicant must be/or have been active in 4-H for 3 or more years.
- Applicants can be in any field of study at any Institute of their choice.
- Applicants must reside in Clay County, Indiana.

Application:

 Student must complete and submit application, by <u>April 15th</u> to Clay County Extension Office. With a list of achievements they have accomplished with in school and in 4-H, and a 500 word essay on "What I have Learned in 4-H".

Selection:

- Selection criteria will be based on scholastic achievement, school and 4-H involvement and essay.
- Decision of Scholarship winners is final.

Notification:

• Scholarship winners will be recognized at the 4-H awards program during the Clay County Fair.

Essay/ Application Requirements

All applicants must complete and essay on: "What I have Learned in 4-H". Your essay must be 500 words, typed and double-spaced. In addition to your essay, please provide a cover page with your name, address, phone number and e-mail, if applicable.
