2022 CLAY COUNTY 4-H FAIR ADULT & YOUTH OPEN CLASS EXHIBITS

Clay County Farm Bureau is sponsoring an Adult & Youth Open Class in Home Economics at the Clay County 4-H Fair. **THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO ANY ADULT OR YOUTH (INCLUDING 4-H MEMBERS & OTHERS) WHO ARE A CURRENT RESIDENT OF CLAY COUNTY.** The committee is urging all interested people to enter.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Entries in Adult & Youth Open Class exhibits are limited to present residents of Clay County or members of a Clay County Homemakers Club or 4-H Club.
- 2. Entrants must be 6 years of age and older.
- 3. ARTICLES MUST HAVE BEEN MADE SINCE THE 2021 CLAY COUNTY FAIR.
- 4. Entries are to be brought to the Exhibit Hall at the 4-H Fairgrounds, Thursday, July 14 3–7 p.m.
- 5. Entry forms are turned in with the exhibit.
- 6.Articles will be cared for, but the Fair will not be responsible for articles damaged, lost or broken.
- 7. All exhibits will receive ribbons. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each category.
- 8. ALL EXHIBITS WILL BE RELEASED THURSDAY, JULY 21 6:00-9:00 P.M. AND ON FRIDAY, JULY 22 8:00 10 A.M. IN THE EXHIBIT HALL. YOU WILL NEED TO SIGN OUT EACH EXHIBIT.
- 9. The committee will not be responsible for exhibits left after 9 p.m., Friday. All unclaimed exhibits will be taken to the Extension Office for pick-up.

FOOD RULES

- 1. All entries in the culinary department must be homemade. All entries must be signed in and signed out when exhibits are released. **ALL FOOD MUST HAVE A 4 X 6 CARD WITH PRINTED RECIPE** attached to the entry for judging. Please do not not put your name on recipe card.
- 2. Exhibitors may make entries in as many categories as they desire: but only one entry can be made in any one class. Example: 1 cherry pie, 1 peach pie, 1 apple pie, but not 2 cherry pies.
- 3. Bring all food exhibits to the Fair in amounts stated and on a paper plate or cardboard and in a plastic bag, either ties or zip-lock. NO plastic wrap!

SAFETY RULES FOR FOODS ENTERED INTO COUNTY-AND STATE-WIDE COMPETITIONS:

- Baked Product Competitions:
 - Uncooked and cooked components, including filling, frosting, glazing, pie filling, and meringue, must not contain cream cheese, whipped cream, unpasteurized milk or uncooked eggs/egg whites (these require refrigeration).
- No home-canned fruits, vegetables, or meats are permitted in products.
- Recipes must be provided that show which ingredients were used in each part of the product.
- Contestants should carefully wash their hands and make sure that their hands do not have any open cuts before preparing foods.
- Whenever possible, baked products should be transported and stored in chilled coolers (41 degrees Fahrenheit).

Judges and individuals who will consume products from county and state competitions should be informed that they are at risk for food borne illness since the established policy cannot guarantee that an entry which is a potentially hazardous food has been properly prepared or handled before, during or following the competition.

FOOD PRESERVATION COMPETITIONS - CANNING ENTRIES

- 1. Display products in regular canning jars. All products must be displayed with seal and ring.
- 2. Canned products will not be opened and tasted.
- 3. ALL FOOD PRESERVATION ENTRIES MUST HAVE 4 X 6 CARD WITH PRINTED RECIPE attached to the entry for the judging. Please do not not put your name on recipe card. INCLUDE METHOD OF CANNING USED (i.e. waterbath or pressure canner).
