For example, you may have signed up for Sheep in 4HOnline (and registered your animal on time), and in Fair Entry, you declare that you have a Shropshire Ewe. Another example would be that you signed up for Arts and Crafts, and in Fair Entry, you declare that you are bringing an oil painting.

Make sure to attend your club meetings in June as your leaders will prepare you for upcoming 4-H Fair responsibilities and deadlines.

Lastly, as you are working on and finishing your 4-H projects, make sure you are having fun and enjoying the process. Don't just throw something together because you "have" to. Have fun, make mistakes, and recognize the learning and knowledge you're gaining in the process.

# Fair Entry Registration is open from May 19 - July 01, 2025

- **1.** Go to the Fair Entry website at <a href="https://daviess-county.fairentry.com">https://daviess-county.fairentry.com</a>
- **2.** Sign in using your 4HOnline email and password.
  - **3.** Follow instructions on screen to register an exhibitor and then add entries for that exhibitor.
- 4. Add other exhibitors (siblings) if needed. It is easiest if siblings register at the same time and your family submits one registration. Otherwise, you will need to wait until the first one is approved before you continue.
- **5.** When all exhibitors and entries have been added, click "Continue to Payment" (payment due will be \$0.00).
  - **6.** When everything is finished, click on the green "Submit" button.
- 7. You will receive an email when the registration is submitted and then another email letting you know if your entry was approved or rejected. If your entry was rejected, a reason will be listed and you will be able to log in and fix the problem before submitting that entry again.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 in each class and prizes to the top 2.




