- <u>Submit a completed application signed by your club leader (or Youth Extension Educator)</u> to the Dearborn County Extension Office by 4:30pm on August 16, 2024.
- One form must be completed for each project and only activities related to that specific project should be included.
- If the project you completed has more than one discipline or category, please include details of the project in the title. (Example-Shooting Sports-Archery; Sewing-wearable.)
- If you competed in more than one discipline, you must submit a form for EACH category (example Shooting Sports-Rifle (one form); Shooting Sports –Pistol (one form)
