

## CLOVER CORNER-

Bundling Q-tips together is a great way to paint, especially for small hands. Just grab a bunch and use a rubber band to secure. Then, using a canvas or art paper, use a paint brush to draw a tree, making the trunk and limbs. Allow to dry. Next squeeze fall colored acrylic paints onto a paper plate. Dip the bunch of Q-tips into the paint as desired, and dab all around the tree branches until it looks the way you want. Allow to dry and display in your favorite spot!
