Modeling tips will be given at 6:00 P.M and immediately following, judging of outfits begins. The project order is Consumer Clothing, Wearable Art and concludes with Sewing.

**The Public Fashion Revue is Tuesday, June 18 at 5 P.M.** on the Haag Ford Stage or if raining-Agner Hall where participants model their outfits and judging results are revealed. **You must participate in both the judging evening, June 10, and the public Fashion Revue, June 18, in order to receive ribbons and awards.**

Do not add Fashion Review to your Fair Entry, as it is for State Fair Fashion Review only.
