## CLOVER CORNER-COLOR ME A RAINBOW

Spring is a good time to think about Rainbows as we see sunshine and moist skies. What causes a rainbow? When sunlight hits a raindrop, some of the light is reflected into different wavelengths, each reflected at a different angle. This creates a separation of colors, producing a rainbow.



You can make your own rainbow by placing a small mirror in a clear glass. Fill the glass with water. Shine a flashlight through the glass at the mirror and look for the rainbow on the wall. You may need to darken the room to better see. Draw what you see.

- ◆ May 15 is the deadline for 4-H enrollment, 4-H project drop/ add and all livestock must be registered in 4-H online.



## Things You Need to Know

- If you are showing livestock at the county fair, (not rabbit), you must have a premise ID from the Indiana Board of Animal Health. - Hunter Education Course will be offered on March 22-23 at Agner Hall on Lawrenceburg Fairground. Time requirement: March 22-6-9 pm, March 23 9-4 pm. Not required to participate in Shooting Sports but encouraged for educational knowledge. Register at https:// www.register-ed.com/events/view/207702 [click and paste into browser]
- All animal project members [except dog, cat & pocket pets] must complete the Quality Livestock Care training this year in order to exhibit at the local and state fair. Training dates: April 27, 12-1 pm, Agner Hall; & May 16, 5:30-6:30 pm Extension Office meeting room. YQCA certificates will still be accepted for online completion. Send certificates to Liz at ebeiers@purdue.edu.
- ◆ The Tractor, Lawn and Garden and Zero Turn <u>operator skills contests</u> will no longer require a written test; only parts ID and obstacle course completion.
