Decatur County Expectations

THIS IS A COUNTY ONLY PROJECT. Project manuals will need to be presented at the time of judging. Green books can be utilized to hold record sheets and project manuals. The information card will be provided by the office.

Exhibit Guidelines

Youth will select either dent corn, sweet corn or popcorn. An information card containing planting date, population, and row width must be included with the exhibit. All exhibits will be judged together within a division. Blue, red, and white ribbons will be awarded on the quality of the exhibit as determined by the judge. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be chosen in each division at the discretion of the judge. From the Champions, a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected.

Exhibit Class Guidelines:

Beginner (grades 3-5)

Youth will exhibit two (2) stalks of corn. Youth may select dent corn, sweet corn or popcorn. An information card containing planting date, population, and row width must be included the exhibit.

Intermediate (grades 6-8)

Youth will exhibit two (2) stalks of corn. Youth may select dent corn, sweet corn or popcorn. An information card containing planting date, population, and row width must be included with the exhibit.

Advanced (grades 9-12)

Youth will exhibit two (2) stalks of corn and one bare root system with one (1) foot of stalk. Youth may select dent corn, sweet corn or popcorn. An information card containing planting date, population and row width must be included with the exhibit.
