Decatur County Expectations

THIS IS A COUNTY ONLY PROJECT. Project manuals will need to be presented at the time of judging. Participants should complete two activities per year from project book. Green books can be utilized to hold record sheets and project manuals. The information card will be provided by the office. 4-H youth must have been enrolled in the Soybean project the previous year to be eligible for the Grain - Soybeans project.

Exhibit Guidelines

All exhibits will be judged together within a division. Blue, red, and white ribbons will be given on the quality if the exhibit as determined by the judge. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected in each division at the discretion of the judge. From the Champions, a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected.

This project will show the complete process from planting through harvest.

Exhibit Class Guidelines:

Beginner (grades 4-6)

Youth will exhibit one (1) gallon of produce, preferably in a glass jar. An information card containing variety and yield must be included with the exhibit.

Intermediate (grades 7-9)

Youth will exhibit one (1) gallon of produce, preferably in a glass jar. An information card containing variety and yield must be included with the exhibit.

Advanced (grades 10-12)

Youth will exhibit one (1) gallon of produce, preferably in a glass jar. An information card containing variety and yield must be included with the exhibit.

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
