It is vitally important that volunteers are enrolled if they intend to participate in a 4-H sponsored event/meeting/program. While there is no established state deadline for completion of the re-enrollment process, individuals need to understand that they should not be serving in a volunteer role with the 4-H program until they have completed their re-enrollment for the new program year.
