### Decatur County Expectations

The information card will be provided by the office. The activities referenced within the divisions below will be provided by the office.

### Exhibit Guidelines

Youth will exhibit five (5) soybean plants with an information card containing planting date, population and row width. All plants exhibited shall include bare roots tied together, to hang upside down. All exhibits will be judged together within their divisions. Blue, red, and white ribbons will be given on the quality of exhibit as determined by the discretion of the judge. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected in each division at the discretion of the judge. From the Champions, a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected.

Grade 8: Complete activity 8

*Advanced (grades 9-12 suggested)*

Grade 9: Complete activities 9 & 10

Grade 10: Complete activities 11 & 12
