(State Fair Exhibit)

State Fair Entries: 2 exhibits per county

Additional Paperwork: Dubois County will no longer be requiring extra paperwork for exhibits. If selected for State Fair, all arts and craft exhibits must include a [4-H Craft Information Card, 4-H 618A](#). This information card is to describe work completed so the judge can more accurately evaluate the exhibit. Craft information cards are for judging purposes only and will not be returned to the exhibitor.

Overall Exhibit Guidelines:

- Exhibits must be a small-scale replica and meet the following criteria:
- Must be of injected styrene plastics
- Wood, paper, clay, die-cast, or snap together models are not permitted
- Screws are not permitted
- Pre-painted or pre-decaled factory models are not permitted

Do not mount models in such a way as to prohibit them from being fully examined by the judge. Attach label by string directly to model to prevent loss.

If the model is being built from a kit, include a copy of the instructions with the craft information card.

Exhibits will be entered into the following classes for judging: Beginner: Grade 3-5; Intermediate: Grade 6-8; Advanced: Grade 9-12. All Levels - 4-H members can exhibit 1 or more projects utilizing different techniques and projects were completed in the current year.

Each year the exhibit should be more advanced than the previous year.
