July 1st - Proof of Completed Youth for the Quality Care of Animals or Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Certificates due to be **eligible for animal shows** (Livestock animals. No quality care certificate needed for cat, dog, horses, llamas and alpacas, and small pets)

July 5th – FairEntry due to receive project labels and have a smooth check in.



Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Training

To exhibit BEEF CATTLE, DAIRY CATTLE, SWINE, SHEEP, MEAT GOATS, DAIRY GOATS, POULTRY, and RABBITS, 4-H members must be certified through the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care training OR the online Youth for the Quality Care of Animals program (YQCA).

For those who have not completed the ANNUAL Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Training, you can fulfill the requirements by doing the following:

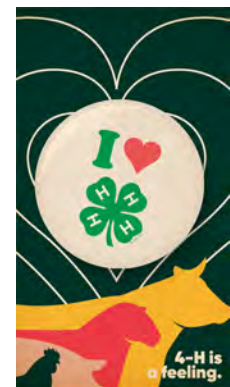

4-H Fair Entry



REQUIRED FOR FAIR

It's that time of year again to enter exhibits in Fair Entry for fair. Fair Entry is the system we use during fair time. Fair Entry helps us print entry labels, check-in projects, create judging sheets, enter results, and create show bills.

Fair Entry is open and located at duboiscounty-indiana.fairentry.com. Families will use same email and password from 4-H Online. 4-H Online sends project/animal information to Fair Entry. We request that all families have their exhibits entered into Fair Entry by June 24th, so we can have labels printed and handed to families in advance of project check-in. We are happy to assist members and families with this process.

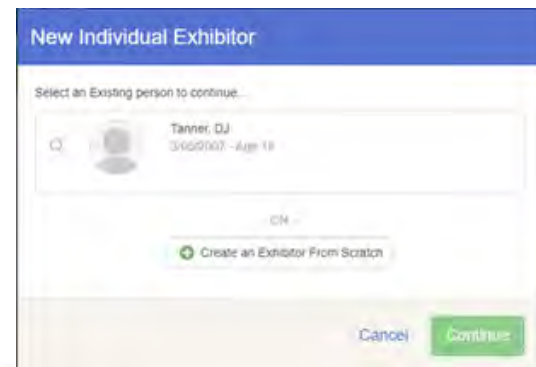

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Go to the FairEntry website at <http://duboiscounty-indiana.fairentry.com>
2. Sign in using your 4HOnline email and password.
3. Follow instructions on screen to register an exhibitor and then add entries for that exhibitor.



4. Please note only certain departments are open at this time. Select the department, division, and then the specific class you wish to enter.

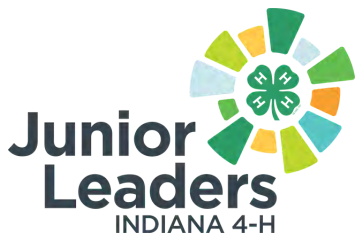
