Flowers will be distributed from the paved parking lot in front of the ECCC. We will arrange club orders based on how they can most efficiently and effectively be placed. Clubs that are moving their plants to another location will be placed for easy access with trucks/trailers.

Flowers will arrive at the Fairgrounds on Wednesday, April 26, 2023. We plan to start unloading at 9:00am and continue until all trucks are done. (Usually about 4 hours.)

Club leaders, advisory board parents and 4-H parents are encouraged to help with the unloading. (For safety reasons, we request that small children not be present during unloading since large equipment will be moving around.)

Once all flowers have been unloaded and 4-H Corporation has a final count of plants, plants will be released to clubs who have helped unload and have an authorized person to take charge of the club's order.

Clubs that are not able to help unload are requested not to pick-up and/or start their distribution until 2:00pm.

All plants must be removed by 7:00pm Wednesday, April 26th.
