Junior Division 2:00  
Completed 3rd grade

Rules

- 1 Two divisions: Senior completed 9th grade and Junior completed 3rd grade.
- 2 Contestants must clip in designated area.
- 3 Only one (1) other 4-Her may hold the animal being clipped.
- 4 NO advice from any adult or 4-Her will be allowed.
- 5 Contestants for Senior division will have 1 hour and Junior division will have 1 1/2 hours.
- 6 Animal being clipped must be shown on Tuesday, unless preapproved by clipping contest 4-H project leader.
- 7 Judging will begin immediately after time expires.
- 8 There will be NO extra time giving for faulty equipment.
- 9 Judges will take into consideration the amount of improvement made to the animal.
- 10 Contestants may use other 4-Hers dairy animals or non 4-H dairy animals preapproved by clipping contest 4-H project leader.
- 11 Ribbons and cash awards will be presented at the banquet.
- 12 The winner of the Junior group automatically moves up to the Senior group. The winner of the Senior group cannot compete anymore.
- 13 Judges pay will be \$150 for the day and normal dairy advisory mileage reimbursement.
- 14 Top three (3) places will be announced for each division.
