## 4-H CONTAINER GARDEN CONTEST 2022



## **DETAILS:**

- Location of competition will be at the south side of the ECCC.
- Purpose of the contest is to encourage participation by 4-H Clubs to help add beauty and interest to the fairgrounds during the fair.
- All Elkhart County 4-H Clubs are eligible and encouraged to participate.
- Each container will be identified with a laminated card indicating the Club name following the judging of the containers.
- Judging will be completed by the first Friday evening of the fair and results will be announced during the fair.
- Places will include 1st, 2nd and Presidents' Choice.
- There will be recognition of this year's winners.

## **GUIDELINES:**

- Registration and container pick-up deadline is Tuesday, June 21, 2022 and will take place at the Purdue Extension Elkhart County office.
- One container will be provided per club. Containers and their plantings will remain the property of the 4-H fairgrounds following the fair, and will be used to decorate various locations around the fairgrounds after the fair is over. Therefore, you should not plan on using materials in your container that you wish to keep.
- Container check-in will be Thursday, July 21, 2022 between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Clubs will check-in at the Purdue Extension Elkhart County office where they will be directed to place their container in an area designated with a flag/stake and located south of the ECCC.
- After the fair is over DO NOT remove or put your containers in storage on the fairgrounds. They will be picked up by staff and all stored in the same location, to be ready for distribution the following year.
- Containers will be watered before and during the fair, but it is the responsibility of each club to maintain the plantings within the container.
- A combination of shrubs, perennials, herbs and annuals may be used, or a single plant is acceptable and should be planted in soil. Please refrain from purchasing an arrangement from a professional landscape or nursery.
- Accents other than live plantings should be kept to a minimum. The Elkhart County Fairgrounds retains the right to remove any decorations they determine may distract from the container.
