Decorated Wall Hanging

Purpose: Decorative Not Functional

Artistic Art Works made from various materials that can be used to enhance the home.

The Project will be judged based on overall appearance, skill and originality.

Article(s) must be ready to hang on a hook or nail (pop tabs are unacceptable) Hangers must hold the weight of the article. It is best if the hanger is hidden and does not detract from the appearance of the article.

All Levels must meet Theme Requirements:

Holiday or Special Occasion themed.

Includes: Holidays (Christmas, 4th of July, Halloween, etc.), Special Occasions (bridal shower, baby shower, birthday, etc.), Special Interests (color theme, sports theme, etc.) or Seasonal (spring, summer, fall, winter). If using a bow, a self-made bow is required.

Members are encouraged to experiment with different materials or combinations of natural and/or man-made materials. Suggestions: beads, lace, ribbon, silk flowers, wire, burlap, fabric, shells, sea glass, paper, paint chips, clay, wool, glass mirrors, leather, pom-poms, tassels, vinyl lettering (signs), canvas (not painting or drawing), moss, repurposed items, macrame, etc.

Level A (grades 3 & 4) (must be themed)

- Exhibit one finished article that shows basic learning skills for a given technique. (Kits are allowed).
- Finished article should be no smaller than 4"X 4" (16 square inches) and no larger than 25"X 25" (625 square inches).
- Article must be ready to hang (no pop-tabs). If using vinyl, only 1 dimensional is acceptable in level A.
- **Suggested Projects Include:** simply decorated wreath, which includes a selfmade bow, pressed flowers, tooling, pom-poms or tassels.

Level B (grades 5 & 6) (Must be themed)

• Exhibit one finished article that shows an improvement of skill and application of Color or design.

- Finished article should be no smaller than 6"X6" (36 square inches) and no larger than 35"X35" (1225 square inches)
- Article must be ready to hang. (No pop-tabs). If using vinyl, should be more than 1 dimensional for level B.
- **Suggested projects include:** Decorated wreath includes a self-made bow, masquerade mask, tole painting, board, doors or windows.

Level C (grades 7, 8, 9) (Must be themed)

- Exhibit one finished article that shows an advancement of skill and application of color or design.
- Finished article should be no smaller that 8"X 8" in size and no larger than 35" X 35" in size.
- .**Article must be ready to hang. (no pop-tabs)** If using vinyl multiple dimensions are required. Original design and pattern required.
- Suggested projects include: Decorated wreath including a self-made bow, masquerade mask, tole painting, board, door, window.

Level D (grades 10, 11, 12) (must be themed)

- Exhibit one finished article that shows an advancement of skills and application of color or design.
- Finished article should be no smaller than 8"X 8" in size and no larger than 52" X 52" in size.
- Articles must be ready to hang. (no pop-tabs) If using vinyl multiple dimensions are required. The use of 3 or more colors are also required.
- **Suggested projects include:** a grouping of up to 3 items (a grouping of up to 3 items is considered 1 finished article) Items for a dorm room, stained glass, tole painting, windows or doors, wall herb garden, etc.

Diamond art and string art are not considered a decorated wall project.
