What is a Premises ID?

If you are planning to show livestock (excluding rabbits, cats, dogs, and horses), it is important that you obtain a Premises ID number from the Indiana State Board of Animal Health (BOAH). A Premises ID is a unique number assigned to the place where your animals are kept. This is part of the national animal traceability program, and allows for tracking and movement of animals. This is important for animal health and safety. You will have to have this information with you when you ID your animal for the 4-H program. Premises ID numbers are free, and easy to get. You can obtain yours by visiting BOAH's website www.in.gov/boah or by at calling 877-747-3038.

Animal Information

What is 4HOnline?

4HOnline is our web-based data management system. This is where you sign up information, projects and Animal ID information. This allows the Purdue Extension office and 4-H Club leaders to generate reports and other items that they need to inform you of events, and project information. You as a 4-H family can read our newsletters, update your contact information and sign up for events using the V2.4HOnline system. It is important if you move, or change a phone number or email address that you update that information in your family profile. To access this website go to:

What is FairEntry?

FairEntry is our data management system for items related to the fair. This system is where classes are selected, auction information is generated, and show programs are managed. All 4-H Livestock members will need to log into this system using their V2.4HOnline profile to place their animals into their proper classes, sign up for showmanship and other club events. It is important that you complete this information when you receive the instructions at the end of May. Not completing this information makes the fair check in process take longer.

Quality Assurance Program Requirement

Last year, Purdue moved to it's own program for youth on Quality Assurance called: Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care. This program is for Beef, Dairy Feeder, Dairy, Lamb, Swine, Goat, Poultry and Rabbit exhibitors. This program will allow the youth to learn more about:

*Their role in food animal production	*Food Safety
*Animal Care	*How to use the life skills members learn from their projects.

The Indiana 4-H Livestock Quality care program will only be offered in person and is \$3.00 payable at the door during the class. You will need to pre-register by calling Nancy Borkholder at the Extension office or email your registration to nborkhol@purdue.edu. Indiana 4-H will recognize the Youth for Quality Care of Animals program this year as we transition, but this will only be offered online at: https://yqcaprogram.org The online version is \$12.00. If you chose to complete the online version, you must email or drop off a copy of the certificate to the Extension office.

The requirement will need to be completed by June 15, 2024 in order to be able to show at the Elkhart County 4-H Fair.

Animal Identification

Identification is an important part of your animal project. This will assist in making sure that you keep good records, and know which animal is which. Below is the identification methods that are used by the 4-H program. This is the information that you will need to enter into the 4HOnline system, please check the club deadlines on the next page and verify with your club leaders if you have questions.
